



Patient information letter

Dear Madam,

You have been diagnosed with cancer during your pregnancy or have had cancer treatment in the past and questions regarding your future fertility or pregnancy. The diagnosis of cancer during pregnancy is not common, only in about 1 in 1000 to 2000 pregnancies. Therefore, little is known about the treatment of cancer during pregnancy and the consequences of the treatment for you and your child. Because of this, your doctor asked for recommendations of the Advisory Board on Cancer, Infertility and Pregnancy (ABCIP). The ABCIP consists of a group of experts from all over the world, and formulates their recommendations based on literature and their own experiences, in order to contribute to the optimal treatment for pregnant women with cancer and women with questions regarding their future fertility. The ABCIP only gives non-binding recommendations, and emphasizes that your physician discusses the treatment options within the team of your hospital and with you. The ABCIP can therefore never be held responsible for any adverse outcomes or (unforeseen) side effects.

We want you to know that your doctor only uses non-specific and pseudonymized (patient) data for this request, so the information we get and the recommendation letter we send back to your physician cannot be linked by us to you personally. Your name and other identifying personal data will not be communicated to us. All communication will be between your physician and us. Your pseudonymized data will be stored in our database for 5 years, in case of any follow-up questions by your physician. Feel free to reach out to us via your physician if you want us to erase your data.
